

EVENTS AT CAULFIELD COMMONS

Overview

Caulfield Commons features a range of event spaces and areas that can be booked for special events and activities. These areas can be configured based on the size and needs of each event, including parking, toilets, food and beverage and activities. Located only 10kms from the CBD, the Commons has direct access to Caulfield Train Station, onsite car parking and is an ideal location for small and large events.

Access

- Direct vehicle access available via Glen Eira Tunnel (clearance: 3.9 metres).
- Pedestrian access via Guineas Tunnel (adjacent to Caulfield Station) and Glen Eira Tunnel.

Western Event Space

The Western Event space is a fully fenced area directly adjacent to the internal public carpark. With direct vehicle access and great public transport connections, the Western Event space also connects to the trainers tower precinct which can provide additional parking, dedicated pick-up drop off bays, elevated outdoor stage and event support areas.

Size
10,000 square metres approx.



Trainers Tower

The Trainers Tower precinct is located immediately adjacent to and connects with the Western Event Space. The area features the old Trainers Tower building which provides elevated views across the Reserve and elevated deck/stage area that is suitable for live entertainment. The area largely consists of compacted gravel that is also suitable for food trucks and activations.

Size
3,000 square metres approx.
(scalable with temporary fencing)



Eastern Event Space and Northern Lake

The Eastern Event Spaces is a slightly undulating grassed area that is directly adjacent to the Northern Lake. With direct access to Caulfield Station via the Guineas Tunnel and vehicle access, it is the perfect outdoor space for medium size events. All facilities can be accommodated on site with direct vehicle access for mobile food and beverage, bathrooms, stages and activations.

45,000 square metres approx.
(scalable with temporary fencing)



Sports Fields

The Sports Fields precinct is a large open span area at the southern end of the Reserve that is suitable for larger open space activities and events. The area can be configured as needed with temporary fencing and utilised in conjunction with other precinct activations.

Carparking, Public Transport and Access

In addition to the central carpark, controlled and secure vehicle access is available to each of the event spaces. All vehicle access is via the Glen Eira Tunnel which is located on the western boundary of the Reserve. Multiple spaces can be configured and utilised to offer onsite parking and dedicated pickup and drop off areas.

The Reserve is directly adjacent to and connected to Caulfield Station via the Guineas Tunnel. Serviced by 3 major train lines (Cranbourne, Pakenham & Frankston) and with services every 3 to 10 minutes during peak, the event spaces are a short five minute walk (300 metres) from Caulfield Station.

Services and Facilities

There are some power and services available within the Reserve (Western Event Space and Trainers Tower) but most events and activations will require mobile services to be brought to site. Further advice and a list of preferred suppliers can be provided upon application.

Racing

Caulfield Common event spaces are not available on declared race days operated by Melbourne Racing Club. All events are scheduled to avoid future race meetings.

Other Facilities

The Commons also features a number of unique buildings and spaces that are available for events and activations. There a range of large stable buildings, smaller grassed spaces and tunnels that can be utilised for smaller events, activations or filming.

Filming

The Reserve provides a broad range of areas and facilities that are ideal for filming. Please contact Caulfield Racecourse Reserve Trust for further information.
